*Please note: Part time teachers (20-34 hours a week) are eligible for 50% of stipend payout on their level. Full time teachers (35 hours or more a week) are eligible for 100% of their stipend payout on their level. E.g., a teacher qualifying for Level 1 stipend who works 20 hours per week would receive \$50, while the same teacher who works 40 hours per week would receive the full \$100.*
