### PROVIDER LIST VOCABULARY

- **Pending:** If a child care provider is in a "Pending" status on this list, they either offered a VPK summer program last year (and are very likely to offer it this year) or they are in the process of being approved by ELCAC to offer it this year. Please contact the provider for "TBD" details.
- **Curriculum:** A planned sequence of instruction to help VPK providers conduct age-appropriate activities and meet the required Florida Standards (<http://www.floridaearlylearning.com/vpk/vpk-providers/the-vpk-class>). "Other" means the provider is using a curriculum that is not yet recognized by the Florida Office of Early Learning (OEL). In that case, please contact the provider for their curriculum details.

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- **Readiness Rate:** A score from 0-100 that is intended to reflect how well the VPK provider prepared their VPK students for Kindergarten. After VPK students graduate, most of them are screened by a trained public-school teacher at the beginning of Kindergarten. During the 2017-2018 Kindergarten school year, a new screening tool called the Star Literacy Assessment was adopted and administered on a computer. The results of each former VPK student (grouped by the VPK provider they attended) are averaged to get the readiness rate for the previous program year. A readiness rate between 60-100 is satisfactory but there is a grace period for the new screening tool to be acclimated. ELCAC works with VPK providers that receive a readiness rate below 60 to ensure improved quality.
