



# SR Maximum Reimbursement Rates

Providers may charge their private paying families any amount they find fit for their childcare business. However, SR services are reimbursed based on a comparison between the provider’s private pay rates and the coalition’s maximum reimbursement rates- whichever is *lower* will be the *approved* reimbursement rates. Furthermore, each eligible SR family will receive a certificate that identifies their unique co-payment which will be subtracted from reimbursement. SR providers are responsible for collecting co-payments within 10 calendar days of their set payment due date (receipts must be maintained).

The Gold Seal SR Maximum Reimbursement Rates are granted to SR providers that have an active Gold Seal status. Gold Seal providers receive a 20% differential above regular rates for the ages listed on their Gold Seal certificate.

Descriptions & Additional Information:

- “Full Time” refers to children attending 6 or more hours per day (such as holidays/summer for school age).
- “Part Time” refers to children attending less than 6 hours per day (such as before/after school for school age).
- The daily rates are calculated by dividing the weekly rates by 5.
- Some children are eligible to receive both SR and VPK funding. Care provided before/after free VPK instructional hours to one of these children is known as “wraparound care.” There is no base rate for wraparound care because it is reimbursed *per child* based on their unit of care and care level.
