PROVIDER LIST VOCABULARY

- Pending:** A pending status means the provider’s VPK summer application with ELCAC is still in progress but is expected to be approved before their start date. You may call the provider for details listed as “pending” as providers often plan in advance and may have more information to share with you.
- Curriculum:** A curriculum is a planned sequence of instruction to help providers conduct age-appropriate activities and meet the required FL Standards (<http://www.floridaearlylearning.com/vpk/vpk-providers/the-vpk-class>). “Other” means that the provider is using a curriculum that is not yet recognized by the Division of Early Learning (DEL).
- Readiness Rate:** The [Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener](#) (FLKRS) is used to gather information about a child's overall development and address their readiness for kindergarten based on the Florida Early Learning Developmental Standards. FLKRS is also used to calculate VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rates which measure how well a VPK provider prepares their students for kindergarten. A score from 0-100 that is intended to reflect how well the VPK provider prepared their VPK students for Kindergarten. After VPK students graduate, most of them are screened by a trained public-school teacher at the beginning of Kindergarten using Star Literacy Assessment. The results of each former VPK student (grouped by the VPK provider they attended) are averaged to get the readiness rate for the previous program year when applicable. A readiness rate between 60-100 is satisfactory. ELCAC works with VPK providers that receive a readiness rate below 60 on a structured Improvement Plan. “N/A” means “Not Applicable” and is used in this list in place of a score if the provider did not have enough students or did not offer VPK in the program year that was last scored.
